1. DUNUKOFIA LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA:

Umudioka I PU 005: Late commencement of accreditation as INEC officials hid election materials leading to abridged accreditation period, thereby disenfranchising many voters

General and open inducement of voters by agents of the ruling party

2. NJIKOKA LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

- a. General late arrival of election materials leading to abridged accreditation period, thereby disenfranchising many voters
The Electoral Officer (EO) admitted being short staffed.
- b. Nimo Ward IV seven (7 Nos) PUs: Disenfranchisement of voters as names of voters with Voter's Card were not found on the Voters Register.

3. OGBARU LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

- a. Ward: Atani II, Aboh Atani I PU: Two different Result Sheets were produced while the original Result Sheet could not be found
- b. Ochucho-Umuodu/Ogbakuba/Amiyi Ward: No Result Sheets in PU 012, 014 and 011.
- c. Ogwuaniocha Ward: No voting took place due to violence, with security agents using teargas to disperse voters while suspected APGA thugs took away the ballot boxes. Total number of registered voters is 3,720.
- d. Okpoko III, PU 005 - Hope Nursery: the Voters' Register was not made available, thus no voting took place. Total number of registered voters is 666.
- e. Okpoko Ward IV: There was no election in PU 006 (Cooperative Road II with 422 Votes), PU 008 (Cooperative Road III) with 410 registered voters; PU 018 (Cooperative Road VI) with 295 registered voters; PU 019 (Umuobom Hall VII) with 553 registered voters, and PU 023 (Ariri Onwu/Ojoto VII) with 266 registered voters. The total number of registered voters in this ward is 1,946.

4. ORUMBA SOUTH LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

Several names of voters were missing from the Voters' Register, leading to massive disenfranchisement of voters.

APC Polling Agents were attacked by suspected APGA thugs

In Enugwu Umuonyia PU 009, there was violence and shooting.

About **17,048** registered voters were disenfranchised in the ward.

REPORT ON THE 16 LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS WHERE INEC REPORTED HAVING ISSUES

1. AGUATA LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

Ekwulobia: Ezekannaya Booth: while 83 voters were accredited, over 200 voted.

Igbo Ukwu II: there was serious cases of disenfranchisement as people were not allowed to vote even with picture and VIN numbered Voters Cards

2. AYAMELUM LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

There was general intimidation of voters by security personnel at Omor II Ward.

Voting was cancelled because of violence including beating of APC Agents.

3. ANAMBRA EAST LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

Generally, there was late arrival of election materials.

There was general intimidation of voters by suspected APGA thugs, to the extent that a policeman attached to PU 005 Umuonumba Square ran away around 1 pm. APC Agents were thoroughly beaten up, especially at Otuocha I, being the ward of the APGA candidate. Agents and supporters scared away. Otuocha II

There was no election as materials were taken away by suspected APGA thugs.

No result sheets were provided by INEC.

In Nsugbe Ward, there was massive disenfranchisement of voters as many voters could not find their names in the voters' register. Voter's names were eventually found in different places than where they were to have voted or where they registered

4. ANAMBRA WEST LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

Five wards were affected in this LGA.

In Abuegbu Iyiora Ward, one Mrs. Ngozi Okoye, the Commissioner for Finance under the ruling APGA party, commanded INEC officials to stop voting

In Mmiata Anam Ward, suspected APGA thugs took away election materials

In Inoma Ward, there was serious violence, as APC Agents were thoroughly beaten up

In Ezi Anam Ward, election materials were torn

5. ANAOCHA LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

There was general intimidation, assault and arrest of APC Agents at Agulu Ward III PUs 001 – 003 and Agulu Ward IV PUs 022 -023

Form EC8As were missing in several polling units

People were allowed to vote without voters' cards

Aguluzoigbo, PU 016: Ballot Box snatched/Official Report made at LGA/Ballot papers recovered

Contrary to the Electoral Act 2010 as amended, APGA National Chairman, Chief Victor Umeh was escorted to the Polling Unit by 4 (four) armed mobile policemen

6. AWKA NORTH LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

Ebenebe I PU: 002 Central, Election Material left without manning by personnel

Late arrival of election material resulting in delayed accreditation and voting

Umuanyaejine Village Hall, PU 007: No personnel to man booth

Amansea, PU 004, Okukwa Village: There was violence fighting leading to cancellation

Late arrival of election material resulting in delayed accreditation; accreditation for only 30 minutes, leading to disenfranchisement of voters.

Achalla Ward III, PU 002: There was general intimidation of voters and APC supporters

There was thumb printing of ballot papers outside the voting precincts

The Presiding Officer illegally and arbitrarily allotted votes to political parties

7. AWKA SOUTH LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

General disenfranchisement of voters, as most voters could not find their names on the Voters Register

Ward VIII, PU 006: No election materials were supplied and INEC officials were absent

Permanent Site: No election materials supplied and INEC officials absent

Agu Awka V: General and open inducement of voters by agents of the ruling party

Nibo: General intimidation of voters

Ward III: Umudioke: Disenfranchisement of voters, as most voters could not find their names on the Voters Register

Ward VIII: No election materials were supplied

Disenfranchisement of voters, as most voters could not find their names on the Voters Register

Ward I: General intimidation and open inducement of voters by agents of the ruling party

Ward VI, Doris Inn: Late arrival of election materials leading to abridged accreditation period, thereby disenfranchising some voters

Umudiana Square: Late arrival of election materials leading to abridged accreditation period, thereby disenfranchising some voters; Form EC8A not compiled at the Ward level

8. IDEMILI NORTH LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

Youth Corpers for the area went on strike for non-payment of allowances by INEC; issue was not resolved until about 1:30 pm.

INEC recruited some students as ad-hoc staff for the election and deployed for the election without training

Late arrival of election materials leading to abridged accreditation period, thereby disenfranchising some voters

The supplied election materials especially Result Sheets and Ballot Papers were mixed up (which were customized for wards and Pus), resulting in another loss of additional two hours for resolution of the mix-up

Accreditation started at about 5:15 pm in Abatete, Oraukwu, Ogidi I and II, Nkpor I and II but was abandoned following non-availability of Result Sheets for the Pus

In the course of accreditation, most of the voters whose surnames started with the letters "O" to "U" (and in some cases "O" to "Z") were omitted from the Voters' Register, though the said names appeared in the displayed Voters' Register in the August registration/review exercise

At Obosi, election did not eventually take place, and was unilaterally rescheduled to a Sunday in a predominantly Christian area and without legal notice to the political parties and the voters

The whole area was heavily militarized on the said Sunday, resulting in intimidation of voters most of who became afraid and stayed away

Illegal thumb printing of ballot papers

9. IDEMILI SOUTH LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

General omission of thousands of names from the voters' register, leading to disenfranchisement of voters. This was highly prevalent in Alor I and II; Ojoto; Nnobi I, II and III; Awka-Etiti, Oba I and II, Nnokwa and Akwukwu.

In Alor I and II, students who posed as NYSC members were also used as Presiding Officers.

In Awka-Etiti Ward II PU 013, the SPO gave out a booklet of ballot papers to the APGA agents for thumb printing which they did. These ballots were included in the valid ballots despite protest by APC agent.

10. IHIALA LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

General disenfranchisement of voters, as most of them could not find their names on the Voters' Register.

Ogbala Ubaha Booth

Ubahudara P/School Ward V

Result Sheet was snatched and torn by suspected APGA thugs

Multiple Result Sheets for several PUs found in one PU.

Whereas there were results for PU 001 and 007, results for Pus 002 – 006 were missing.

PU 022 Uli Amamputu

Result Sheet taken away and later smuggled in

Ogboro Ward: PU 001 to 014

Chuma Nzeribe, an APGA stalwart, snatched boxes and singlehandedly wrote filled out the Result Sheets which were later taken to the LGA Headquarters

Umuegorum Village Square PU 005 – 012

Massive and illegal thumb printing of ballot papers

11. NNEWI SOUTH LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

The Presiding Officers for Osumenyi Ward gave out ballot papers to APGA supporters who openly thumb printed same and these were included as valid ballots

In Ezinifite Ward I, Enugu Awor PU I, II and III, Form EC8A was not supplied by INEC officials to all the PUs even as at the close of voting. The Presiding Officers resorted to entering the voting data in exercise books. When challenged by our Agent, the agent was manhandled and thoroughly beaten up by suspected APGA thugs. This was happening a few metres from a Police Station.

12. ONITSHA NORTH LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

Following electoral malpractices that led to the cancellation of results for PU 008, the Commission failed to cancel other areas where similar malpractices occurred as follows:-

Ward II

There were no result sheets were provided by the Commission for this ward

Ward XI

No Result Sheets were supplied as at 5 pm. The voters had insisted that without result sheets, there would be no voting. Surprisingly, results were produced for the ward.

Ward XI PU 008, PU 014

No result sheets supplied; when complaints were made to the EO, the EO said it was beyond her control. Though voting started late, it was stopped at 4:00 pm, leading to many voters being disenfranchised INEC Supervisor directed security operatives to arrest 14 (fourteen) APC Agents on the false claim that they were fake agents.

INEC officials re-opened accreditation/voting after closing same and upon realizing that APGA was losing

13. ONITSHA SOUTH LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

Following widespread malpractices which led to the cancellation of the result for the entire Fegge Ward VI with 17 PUs, the Commission failed to acknowledge similar malpractices in the following areas:-

Odoakpu Ward III PU Code 003

There was no Form EC8A, but votes were counted and entered on Form EC8B from a piece of paper

Unsurprisingly, the number of votes cast was greater than the number of accredited voters

Bridgehead I, PU 002 and PU 003

The number of votes cast was greater than the number of accredited voters.

Odoakpu Ward VII, PU 002
Suspected APGA thugs attacked APC Agents and leaders

14. ORUMBA NORTH LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

In Nanka Ward II and Omogho Ward, APC Agents were chased away by suspected APGA armed thugs who shot sporadically in the air. Results were thereafter produced.

15. OYI LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

Generally, there was no election in Nteje Ward I with 17 PUs but results were produced. The ward has 5,833 registered voters spread as follows:

Ogbunike Ward II

There was no voting. The Presiding Officer (PO) was taken away by a serving Senator and appeared some hours later with Result Sheets that were already filled out

Umunya Ward I, PU 003 - Central School: Voters were disenfranchised as their names were not found on the Voters' Register even though they had their voting cards

PU 012 – Central School: There was no voting as the assigned personnel was said to have died on the eve of the election; Also, the APGA Transition Committee Chairman was caught on election eve with Voters Cards and Ballot Box

16. EKWUSIGO LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

Ozubulu IV, PU: 001 (Eziora Central School I): There was no voting because of violence

17. ONITSHA SOUTH LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA

One whole Ward was cancelled, namely:-
